SUBTERRANEAN | HARVESTER TERMITES

 Damage to furniture, skirtings, wooden floors, and other wooden structures, indicates that there are subterranean termites on the property.

FLIES | FLYING INSECTS

- Flies regurgitate and excrete wherever they come to rest and thereby mechanically transmit disease organisms.
 House flies can transmit at least 65 diseases to humans,
- including typhoid fever, dysentery, cholera, poliomyelitis, yaws, anthrax, tularemia, leprosy and tuberculosis.

ANTS

- Ants can cause significant damage to buildings and property once a colony is established.
- Even small amounts of food can attract hordes of industrious ants that can carry and transmit bacterial and fungal organisms that are serious disease pathogens.



GELLING

- · Cockroach and Ant gel baits are available with a variety of insecticide formulations.
- Works by enticing the pests to eat gel bait, which it thinks is a source of food, so it consumes the insecticide contained within.

FUMIGATION

- "Fumigants" are more commonly referred to 'gas' in layman terms. Fumigation is often used as a last
- resort when infestation is severe.
- Fumigation is a targeted treatment technique commonly used to effectively control pests that attack stored goods and commodities.

SPRAYING

- Chemicals to be applied are dissolved or suspended in water or, less commonly, in an oil-based carrier.
- The application would be applied in a fine mist spray to areas that are required to be treated.

RODENT BAIT STATIONS

- Unlike mouse traps that only catch one rodent at a time, bait stations work as long as there is enough poison for the rodents.
- A single ounce of bait kills around twelve mice while four ounces is enough to eliminate ten rats.

SOIL POISINING | DRILL & INJECT

- · Repellent termiticide makes the treated area toxic to termites and repels them. It is one of the most used measures during pre-construction.
- Non-repellent termiticide doesn't repel termites, instead they invade the poisoned soil and die. Non-repellent termiticides create confusion amongst the termites and they become unable to identify the soil enriched with the termiticide. Therefore, they avoid the treated area and this leads to the eradication of the termites.

INSECT FLY LIGHTS | REDTOP FLYGO BAGS

- Insect Fly Lights and Redtop Flygo Bags placed around a home or business reduce housefly populations.
- Insect Fly Lights with distinctive UV spectrums are also well-known for attracting flies and trapping them.
